SACCPI- Practicum I

This is a course guides the student to interpret the APS with under supervision, which includes the Administration of 10 APS and Submission of 10 Case Studies describing how they APS was administered and interpreted.

SACC002- Basic Life Coaching

Introduction to the field of Christian Life Coaching.

SACC003- Intermediate Life Coaching

A practical course that assists the student in identifying and exploring a coaching specialty.

An action plan is developed to prepare for coaching in this specialty area.

SACC-004- Advanced Life Coaching

A practical course that assist the student develop and action plan for launching their coaching ministry.

SACC005- Stress Management

All change produces stress and coaching produces change. This is a practical course that prepares the student for managing the stress they experience as a coach and the stress of those they coach.

SACCPII- Practicum II

This is a course guides the student to interpret the APS with coaching clients under supervision, which includes the Administration of 10 APS and Submission of 10 Case Studies describing how they APS was administered and interpreted within the context of coaching.

Faith-Based Community Development - Northwind Institute

Northwind Institute and WorldHope Corps have partnered to offer a certificate in Asset Based Community Development.

This certificate program has been designed for faith-based organizations seeking to transform their communities from the inside out, as an alternative approach to traditional community ministry to and for the poor.

This program was reflects the concepts developed by The Communities of Shalom, a ministry initiative of the United Methodist Church.

This certificate program includes four courses:

WHC001- Introduction to ABCD - Tutorial

This is an introductory course which presents the concepts of Asset Based Community Development.

WHC002- ABCD as Ministry - Tutorial

This intermediate course explores how ABCD can be expressed as ministry.

WHC003- ABCD in Action - Tutorial

This advanced course examines case studies which detail how ABCD has been used in specific ministries.

WHC004- Ministry Project – Tutorial

The student researches a specific community need, designs an ABCD approach to addressing that need, and submits a paper detailing the research and plans to address this community need.

Faith-Based Non-Profit Leadership - Northwind Institute

Northwind Institute and WorldHope Corps have partnered to offer a certificate in Non-Profit Leadership.

This certificate program has been designed for staff and board development in small faith-based organizations.

These certificates provide an introduction to the best practices of non-profit leadership in faith-based organizations.

This certificate program includes four courses:

NPL001- Introduction to Non-Profit Leadership

This is an introductory course which presents the concepts leadership within the context of a Faith-Based Non-Profit

NPL002- The Role of the Non-Profit Board

This is an intermediate course which presents the concepts of the Board's role in providing governance, establishing policy, and identifying priorities within the context of a Faith-Based Non-Profit.

NPL003- The Role of the Non-Profit Executive Staff

This is an intermediate course which presents the concepts of the Executive Staff role providing the required leadership to develop programs and services that implement the priorities and policies established by the Board within the context of a Faith-Based Non-Profit.

NPL004 - Leadership Project – Tutorial

The student identifies a specific program which needs to be developed or re-developed. The student's then develops the project and submits a paper detailing the research and planning processes needed to complete the program design or re-design.

Faith-Based Non-Profit Leadership - Northwind Institute

Northwind Institute and WorldHope Corps have partnered to offer a certificate in Non-Profit Institutional Advancement.

This certificate program has been designed for staff and board development in small faith-based organizations.

These certificates provide an introduction to the best practices of non-profit leadership in faith-based organizations.

Northwind Institute also offers consulting services to assist Faith-Based Non-Profits implement Annual Fund Strategies, Capital Campaign Planning, and the development of robust volunteer programs.

This certificate program includes four courses:

NPL005- Introduction to Institutional Advancement

This is an introductory course which presents the concepts fundraising and community support within the context of a Faith-Based Non-Profit.

NPL006- The Annual Fund

This is an introductory course which presents the concepts and best-practices of the Annual Fund which provides support for the operations of the Faith-Based Non-Profit.

NPL007- The Capital Campaign

This is an introductory course which presents the concepts and best-practices of a Capital Campaign which provides support for the building of facilities of the Faith-Based Non-Profit.

NPL008- The Volunteer Program

This is an introductory course which presents the concepts and best-practices of implementing a volunteer staff program to support the operations of the Faith-Based Non-Profit.
